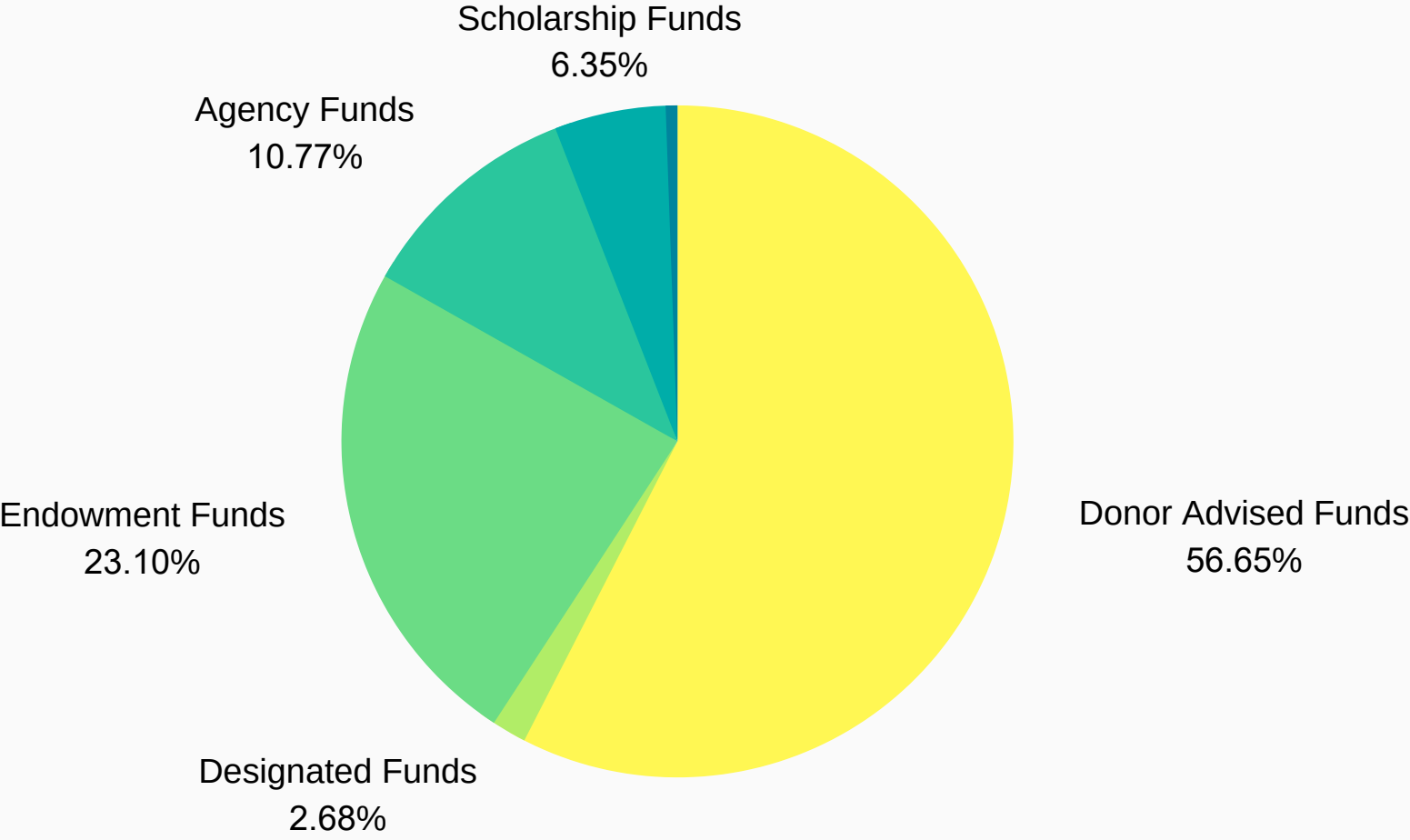

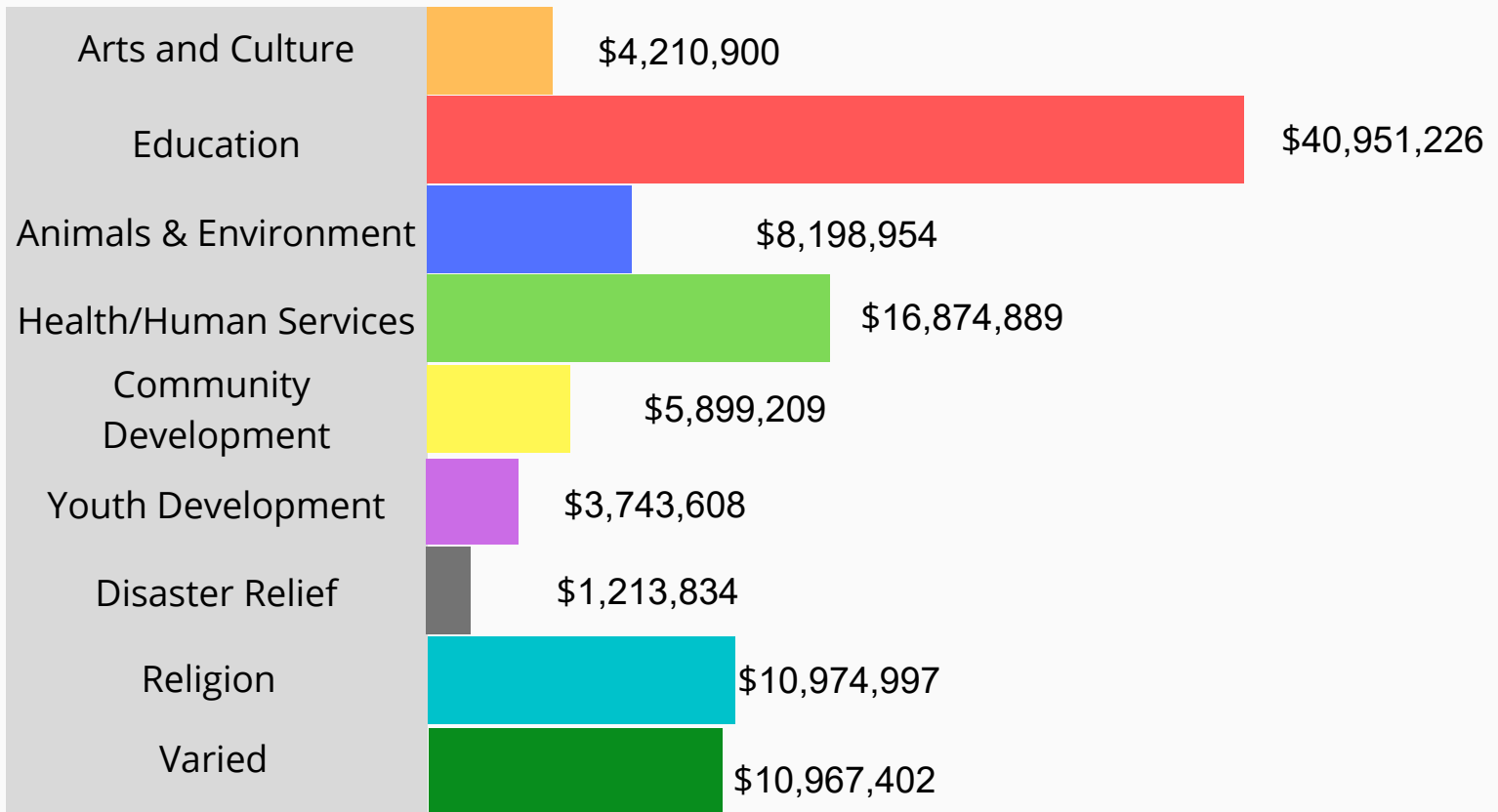

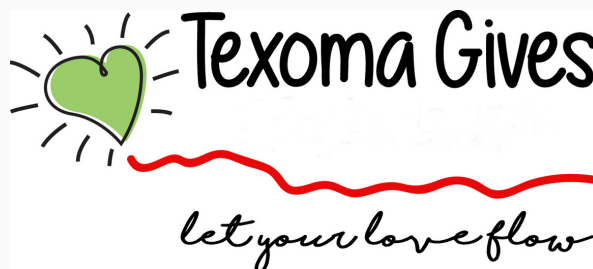
Grants Since Inception

The Wichita Falls Area Community Foundation launched in March 1999 when a small group of forward-thinking philanthropists turned their ideas into action, with a plan to address future nonprofit needs in the Wichita Falls area. Undeniably, their vision launched one of the most important charitable partnerships in this region.



The Foundation is also an important connector, convener, and cultivator for the region. The most visible impact is through Texoma Gives, a single day online giving partnership that, in just six years, has raised over \$7 million for nonprofit organizations in north Texas and southern Oklahoma.
