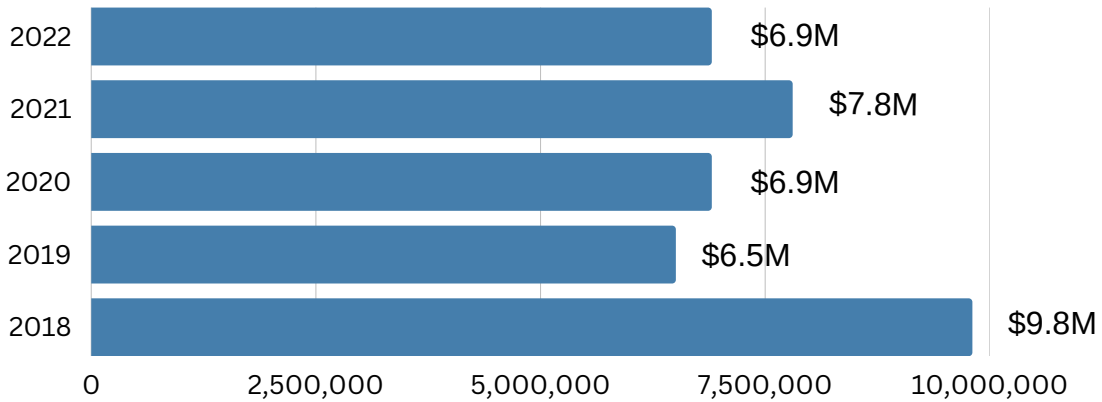

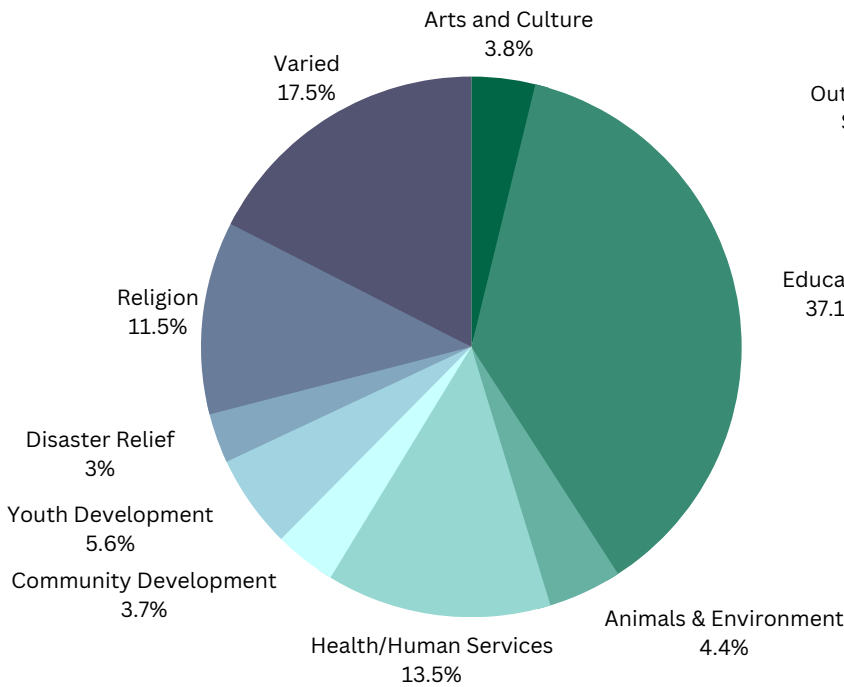

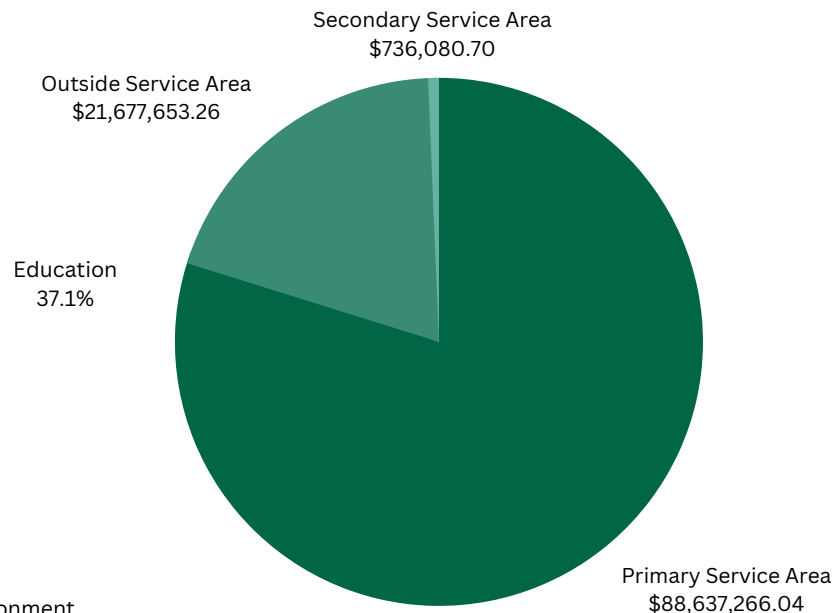

# Scholarship Reception

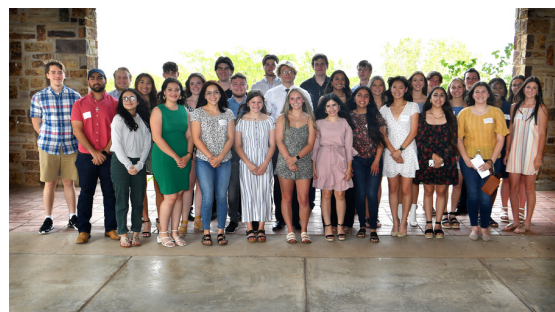
The Wichita Falls Area Community Foundation awarded more than \$479,000 in scholarships to 218 area high school and college students during the Foundation's annual scholarship event in May.



The first scholarship was established at WFACF in 2000. Today, there are 79 scholarship funds at the Foundation, several of which award multiple scholarships annually. Scholarships range from single year to multi-year renewable awards for students in vocational education, as well as undergraduate programs.



The 2022 pool of applicants was one of the largest to date, with some 250 applications submitted.

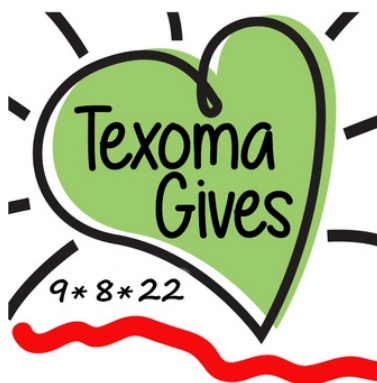




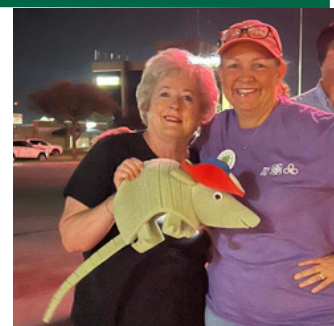
# Texoma Gives

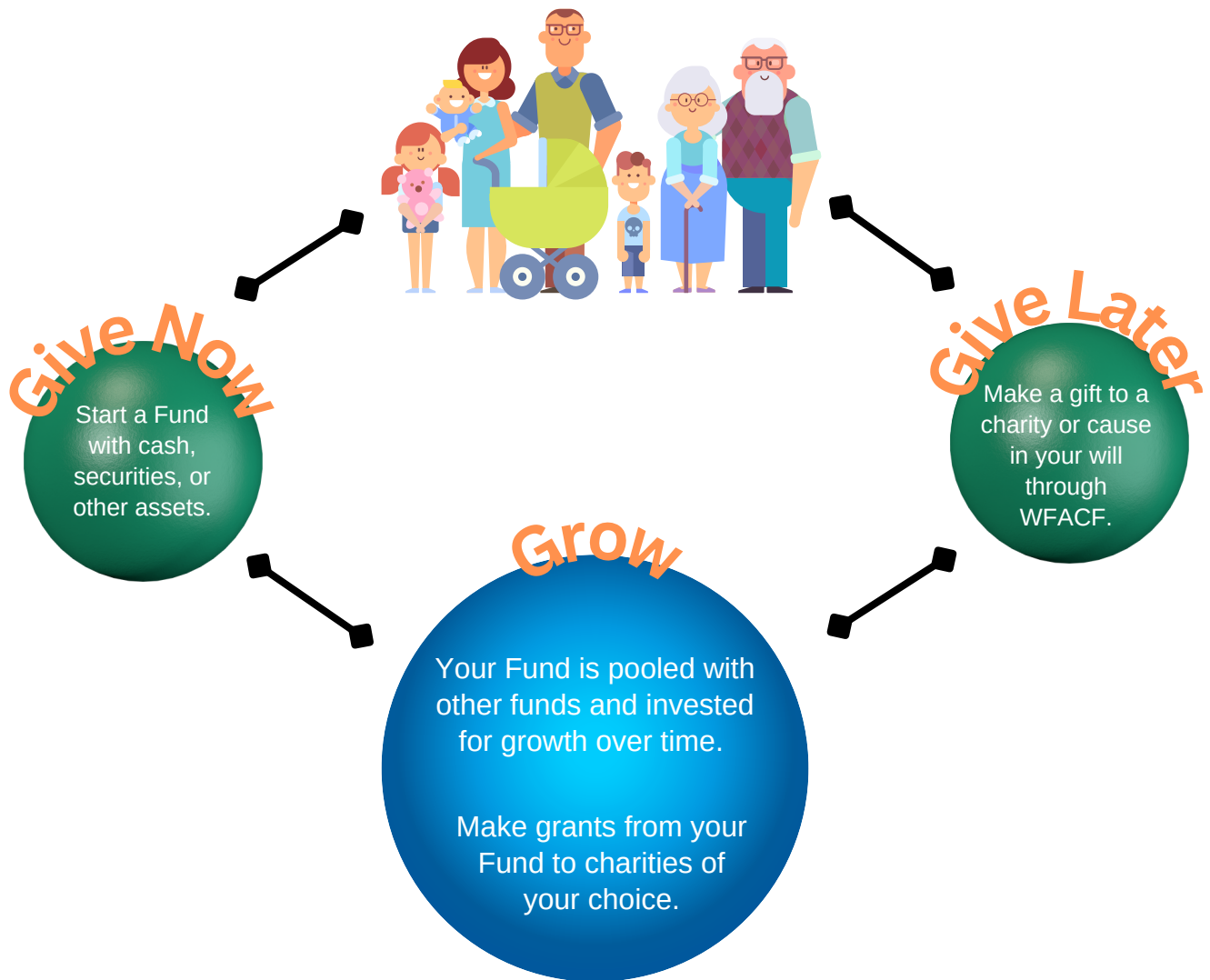
